4.1.2 – Entries Closing:	Friday, October 31, 2025. Late entries contact USAC.
4.1.3 – Number of Cars Admitted:	60 maximum - 15 per class - Qualifying to be run in 2 separate groups .
8.4 – Impound:	As directed by USAC Technical Director
9.7 – Event Logistics:	Exclusively under the direction of USAC Paddock Logistics. Load-in and pit set up as per the schedule. Pre-staging not permitted before 8:00 am, Wednesday, November 4, 2025. Transporter staging is in the Raceplex Parking Lot. Transporters must be in the parking lot prior to their load-in time on the schedule. Load-in. Transport drivers must be at their truck 30 mins before load-in time monitoring CB channel 40. Load-out. Transporters must not move until 6:00 pm, Sunday, November 9 and must vacate the paddock by 10:00 am, Monday, 10 November unless agreed to by USAC and VRoR.

Test Day:	Register and pay fee through USAC entries.

Pit Vehicles:	Pit vehicles must be operated by a licensed driver 18 years of age or older. Teams are permitted one (1) tugger support vehicle in the Paddock area per car entered and they must mark their team name on the vehicle. Golf carts are not permitted in the pits.
False Grid (pre-grid):	On the road leading to pit lane entrance at the top of Paddock Hill.
Pit Lane Assignments:	To be issued by USAC
Pit Lane Equipment:	Hard floor and wall panels are prohibited. The paved area behind the pit boxes back to the fence must be always kept clear as a fire lane. Heaters of any type are prohibited.
Spotter Information:	Prohibited at The Villas
Beacon Location:	Driver's right, Start/Finish
Facility Restrictions:	The Pit Lane sidewalk must always remain clear. See VIR policies page: http://virnow.com/about/policies/ .
Credentials:	Team credentials will be available at registration. Teams are limited to 12 credentials with entry fee. Additional credentials must be purchased at Registration. VRoR and OpMo Staff without USAC credentials may pick up an SEC at Registration.
Paddock: RVs/Garages/Pit Suites:	Through USAC.
Streaming:	The event, including pit lane and podium reporting will be streamed live by USAC on FloRacing.
Live timing:	Live timing will be provided by USAC with AI Kamel Systems.
Heroes Dinner:	A Heroes Dinner will take place at The Gallery on Friday, 7 November beginning at 7:30 pm. It will be a sit-down buffet catered by Scheper Event Group with table wine provided and a cash bar. Team entries include two tickets to the Heroes dinner. Additional tickets, pending availability will be made available. The purpose of the dinner is to celebrate and highlight veteran achievements with Operation Motorsport. A keynote speaker and special presentations will part of the experience.
Veteran Outreach Activity:	VRoR will feature an important Veteran Outreach activity at the Pagoda on Saturday. This activity will include Veteran Support Organizations, Employment and the VA. This will be a no-cost activity and all veterans and active-duty military are welcome to attend.
Veteran Race Car Ride Along:	Operation Motorsport Beneficiaries and selected veterans in attendance will have the opportunity to ride along in the official safety car during certain Course Clearance Laps. No special equipment is required.
Parade Laps:	Parade laps (drive your own car on the track behind a safety car) will be conducted on Saturday, November 8. Up to 3 car groups and one motorcycle group are scheduled. Veterans: Up to 50 cars Active-Duty Military: Up to 50 cars Manufacturer specific: Up to 50 cars Motorcycles: Up to 50 bikes Participants will be parked in designated corrals and informed of registration and staging details there. Participants must be prepared to register and pay the \$25 fee at 9:00 am at their corral. Staging for laps commences at 9:50 am for the first group. No special equipment is required. Drivers need to show a valid license and insurance and passengers to show ID.
