2.5.1 – Length of Racetrack: 3.27 miles, 5.26 kilometers, 17-turn road course

2.5.2 – Direction of the Race: Clockwise

2.5.3 – Pole Position: On the Right

2.5.4 – Location of Race Control: Building behind Pit Lane prior to start/finish, 2nd Floor

2.5.5 – Start/Finish Line: On the Front Straight

Additional Regulations

4.1.4 – Entries Closing: Friday, October 31, 2026. Late entries contact USAC.

4.1.5 – Number of Cars Admitted: 60 maximum - 10 per class - Qualifying to be run in 3 separate groups .

8.4 – Impound: As directed by USAC Technical Director

9.7 – Event Logistics: Exclusively under the direction of USAC Paddock Logistics. Load-in and pit set up as per the schedule.

Pre-staging: Transporter pre-staging is permitted beginning Thursday, Nov 5, after 8:00 am (please do not arrive prior). Pre-staging is exclusively in the Raceplex Parking Lot.

Load-in: Transport drivers must be at their truck 30 mins before load-in time monitoring CB channel 40.

Load-out: V-RoR Transporters must not move until 6:00 pm, Sunday, November 8 and must vacate the paddock by 10:00 am, Monday, November 9 unless agreed to by USAC, VIR and V-RoR.

19.7.5 – Tires: Michelin is the official tire of the event. Teams may order tires prior to the race. The brand, type and number of tires allowed to be used during the race is not restricted. All race tires used in Practice, Qualifying and the Race must have at least 200 tread wear rating.

Michelin will donate \$100 to Operation Motorsport for every set of Michelin tires sold for the Race of Remembrance event. The donation will go to further the mission of Operation Motorsport. False Grid (pre-grid):	On the road leading to pit lane entrance at the top of Paddock Hill.
Pit Lane Assignments:	To be issued by V-RoR

Pit Lane Equipment:	Hard floor and wall panels are prohibited. The paved area behind the pit boxes back to the fence must be always kept clear as a fire lane. Heaters of any type are prohibited.
Spotter Information:	Prohibited at The Villas
Beacon Location:	Driver's right, Start/Finish
Facility Restrictions:	The Pit Lane sidewalk must always remain clear. See VIR policies page: http://virnow.com/about/policies/ .
Credentials:	Team credentials will be available at registration. Teams are limited to 12 credentials with entry fee. Additional credentials must be purchased at Registration. VRoR and OpMo Staff without USAC credentials may pick up an SEC at Registration.
Paddock: RVs/Garages/Pit Suites:	Through V-RoR.
Streaming:	The event, including pre-race open grid, pit lane and podium reporting will be streamed live by USAC on FloRacing and Alpha Live and Operation Motorsport YouTube.
Live timing:	Live timing will be provided by USAC with Al Kamel Systems.
Heroes Dinner:	A Heroes Dinner will take place at The Gallery on Friday, 7 November beginning at 6:00 pm. Team entries include two tickets to the Heroes dinner.
